Control of Substances Hazardous to Health Regulations 1988



Products	Tensar geogrids, non-knitted geotextiles and other polymeric products (e.g. bodkins, connectors, braid, pegs).
Physical & chemical characteristics	These products are manufactured from materials that are non hazardous to health and therefore no special precautions are necessary.
Hazard identification	 There may be a risk during handling of cuts or abrasions when handling the more rigid geogrids or needle punched geotextiles which may contain small metal pieces, it is recommended that gloves be worn. In the event of a fire involving these products, care should be taken to avoid inhalation of smoke. Due consideration should be given to the weight of the rolls when being handled.
Protective clothing	The gloves recommended above should conform to BS EN388 with a 4.2.2.4 rating or better.
Disposal	The materials used in these products pose no ecological threat. They can therefore be disposed of responsibly via suitable incineration equipment or landfill in accordance with the local regulations.
